### **Storm Water Pollution Prevention Program (SWPPP) Administration:**

The SWPPP covers the storm water pollution prevention practices that the General Contractor shall employ in accordance with the NYSDEC General Permit Number GP-0-15-002 governing storm water discharges during construction activities. Our firm has extensive experience in the preparation of the SWPPP report including the required quality and quantity calculations required for the various rainfall intensities anticipated in New York State. In addition, our office will prepare the Notice Of Intent application for submission to the NYS Department of Conservation to obtain coverage for the project. In some cases, these reports are submitted to the local agency having jurisdiction for an MS-4 acceptance letter prior to submission to New York State.

Further, our office conducts the required pre-construction meeting with the Contractor and his certified/qualified inspector as well as perform weekly inspections and issue field reports as well as maintain documentation throughout the construction phase. Our firm has five (5) qualified SWPPP Inspectors on staff to handle these needs. At the conclusion of the project, we will work with the owner to complete the Notice of Termination to close out coverage under the NYS DEC General Permit.
